The Larry Singer Studios Summer Intensive is designed for you, the actor to experience physical release, personal insight, expanded emotional range, increased self-expression, and advancement in acting technique. The Intensive will create a significant change in you, moving you forward in your understanding of acting and your ability to accomplish your vision. The program is will emphasize development of the physical instrument, communication, character development, risk and courage, text interpretation and the ability to include more of yourself in your overall work. The Intensive will consist of 16 students.

The Intensive will take place weekdays August 11-20. Classes will meet 10:00am – 5:00pm daily.

About half the sessions will be with Susan Main, a certified Linklater teacher with a background in Alexander Technique. Susan has taught at S.U.N.Y. Purchase, Columbia University MFA program, The Actors' Studio Program at Pace University, The New Actors Workshop and Sarah Lawrence College.

All the other Sessions will consist of Acting Exercises and Scene Study with Larry Singer. Different assignments and exercises will be assigned each student based on their individual needs and previous experience. (For example, Shakespeare exercises, Character development, writing your own work, etc)
